


Diagnostics

Diagnostic capabilities are an essential piece of quality healthcare. At Country View Equine, we were very pleased to be able add an additional, state of the art, ultrasound unit this year. This means that we not only have digital radiography available at all times in the field, but ultrasound as well. Additionally, we are equipped with a Lameness Locator unit to add objectivity to difficult lameness assessments when needed.

Farrier Communication and Education

We are also very committed building a great working relationship with your farrier. We continue to host farrier days as often as possible. These events help us all get to know each other better, allow us to discuss cases and improve our ability to communicate with one another. Both veterinary and farrier professions are challenging and our ability to successfully collaborate, along with our clients, is crucial for successful management and outcomes for your horse.
